I have the honour to inform you that under Self-Finance Scheme (SFS), some seats are reserved in the disciplines of Medicine (MBBS), Dentistry (BDS), Pharmacy (D-Pharmacy) and B.Sc. Engineering for admission of foreign students as well as Pakistan Origin having dual nationality in various colleges/universities of Pakistan for the Academic Session 2007-2008.

For admission under SFS, the students who have acquired their HSSC or equivalent qualifications (either from Pakistan or abroad) are eligible to apply. Application form, general conditions / guidelines and rate of fee etc., can be downloaded from HEC website: www.hec.gov.pk/sfs.

However, while opting for admission in the Dow Medical College & Sindh Medical College, Karachi, a student is required the SAT score of minimum 1500 (in lieu of Entrance test) and for admission in NED University of Engineering and Technology, Karachi, the candidates have also either passed the entrance test of the NED University or passed SAT-I and SAT-II in Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry examinations with minimum of 800 and 1500 score respectively.

You are requested to furnish the nominations of suitable candidates on the prescribed application form along with attested copies of their educational documents (Five copies) to this Commission latest by 31st August 2007.
